Looking at Winter Data/Planning our CSIP -continue looking at data. Still adjusting math intervention to improve greater rate of improvement. Our school is not trending like the rest of the district, which is a positive. We are seeing continued growth at our school but it is slowing down. Are we comfortable keeping CSIP plan? Maintain proficiency in reading and continue with the 1-2 words rate of improvement for those not meeting proficiency. Math, same with math, increase by 2-5% with proficiency. Possibly have a sub goal to help with those students that are proficient. What programs are out there to support and challenge students? Possibly adding a STEAM goal to provide for those proficient students.

Building GRIT and resilience at school and at home – had a good group discussion on what Grit looks like. What we as a school can do to improve the GRIT in the kids at our school. Help kids become more GRITTY. How do we help parents build GRIT at home? Reviewed some concepts from a book Grit In the Classroom. Three types of parents 1)permissive -let anything go, kid is in charge 2)authoritarian-non-negotiable parent 3)Authoritative -a little of the above 2. Grit is like a muscle that you have to develop. Making things difficult for our kids. Work on developing a plan to help parents work with their students on grit over the summer.
