MEETING MINUTES: March 14, 2016

WELCOME & INTRODUCTION: The meeting began at 4:15 p.m.

2015 – 2016 CSIP / LANDTRUST PLAN REVIEW: The group reviewed the 2015 – 2016 goals.

- Language Performance Goals: At Winter benchmark, Granite Elementary was looking strong in most grades. Third grade hasn't reached benchmark and the group discussed increasing intervention for this group. The final report is given in May.
- Math Performance Goals: The staff will be looking at the rate of improvement to try to improve scores by the end of the year.
- PBIS Performance Goals: The students are improving their problem solving skills. Playworks has helped with resiliency.

2016 – 2017 CSIP / LANDTRUST PLAN PROPOSAL: The group reviewed options for the 2016 – 2017 goals.

- The Landtrust Plan is due at the end of this month.
- The next progress and monitoring report is the SRI for third – fifth grade and the CBM for Kindergarten – second grade. These tests are done three times per year.
- The group discussed hiring 2 assistants, buying Flocabulary for third through fifth grade, and \$300 for replenishing of supplies.
- A suggestion was made that we have a list of books for each grade so that the students have ideas for books to read. The list could be put on the website or posted in the library. Biblionasium was also mentioned.
- PBIS: The students have a hard time generalizing respect. Classroom rules are aligned with the school rules and we are continuing to work with brain booster instructors to help show respect across the board to all students. We need to fine tune positive / negative reinforcements and train adults to do more.

2016 – 2017 STAFFING PLAN: Ronnie explained that Granite Elementary was allocated 15 FTE from the district for next school year. The group reviewed many different options for how to allocate the 15 FTE and many in attendance expressed their thoughts about pros and cons of the different options. The current Kindergarten and Second Grade aides will be up for discussion and we are not sure if they will be available next year. Ronnie will decide which direction to take this week so she can start hiring.

SJR 12 PROPOSAL TO AMEND UTAH CONSTITUTION: Nancy Tingey informed the group of pending legislation to be aware of regarding school funding.
