WELCOME: Ronnie welcomed the group and the meeting began at 4:15.

MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING: The group reviewed the meeting minutes from the October meeting and they were approved.

BUDGETS – LANDTRUST AND CELL TOWER: The school has purchased 10 new Chrome Books for 3rd grade. Currently the 4th and 5th grade have a Chrome Book for each student. The third grade is slowly adding Chrome Books to increase the number of computers available for students. Some of the cell tower money has been used to fund bussing for a couple of field trips. Ronnie said detailed reports of these funds are available if anyone from the SCC would like to take a look.

SAFETY DRILLS: The district has asked for some changes this year regarding safety drills at the school. There are several types of drills that the school will hold. Some will include students and some will just involve the staff. Granite will hold a fire drill, bomb threat drill, infectious disease drill, lockdown drill, etc. They have the ability to scan a badge and lock all of the doors in the building in the event of a threat from outside of the school. They also work on drills for a threat that may be inside of the school. Ronnie will be attending some training sessions to understand district procedures for new drills the school will hold.

NEW BOND & HOW IT IMPACTS GRANITE: The bond passed in the election last week. Granite will be receiving a new front office remodel. It may take a couple of years to get through all of the schools on the list and Ronnie does not know when Granite's remodel will take place. She is not aware of the timeline for the skylights. When the remodel is scheduled, it will occur during Summer break.

PLANNING FOR NEXT FAMILY NIGHT: We have an Internet Safety Night scheduled during White Ribbon Week. A date will be established soon. In the Spring, we will host a STEAM night (art auction and STEM activities). We will talk to groups like Mad Science, Mathnasium, etc., to see if they would have an interest in participating.

PARKING LOT EXIT ONLY: Katie asked if we knew when the exit only lanes would be painted in the parking lot. Ronnie said she will follow up.

HOMEWORK: The group had a general discussion about homework. There was a KSL homework debate scheduled to be on television and Tami said she would circulate the link to watch the debate.
